

ASH WEDNESDAY WORSHIP – While it may seem strange that the first day of Lent falls on Valentine's Day this year, St. Paul reminds us that "God proves his love for us in that while we still were sinners Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8). On **Wednesday**, **February 14**, we will begin the holy season of Lent with our Ash Wednesday service at

7:00 pm. The service will include the confession of sins for Ash Wednesday, the imposition of ashes which calls us to "remember that you are dust and to dust you shall return," and the celebration of Holy Communion which reminds us that it was "in the night in which he was betrayed [that] the Lord Jesus took [bread and wine] and said ... 'Do this in remembrance of me." Lent calls us to return to the Lord in worship and service as we prepare ourselves for our observance of Christ's death on the Cross on Good Friday, March 29, and our celebration of the Resurrection of our Lord on Easter Sunday, March 31.
